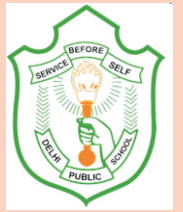
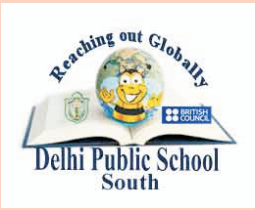


British Food Fest at
